ISH2022 Abstracts

Outstanding research presentations were displayed in Kyoto at the 2022 ISH biennial meeting. These abstracts have now been made available <u>online</u> via the Journal of Hypertension.

MENA RAG

Hypertension remains a major concern in the Middle East and North Africa (MENA) region, with an alarming increase in its prevalence. Countries of the MENA region have gaps in economic situations and other issues such as war and increase in the refugee populations which poses serious concerns in the management of chronic diseases. As we work together to raise awareness and

reduce the impact of hypertension in the MENA region. A session dedicated to UNICEF relief actions for the earthquake that recently hit Syria and Turkey was held on March 4th.

The MENA RAG session about Hypertension management during disasters was chaired by Dr Habib Tarief from Bahrain and Dr Abdulla Shehab from UAE with 78 attendees from 16 countries of the MENA region. The session started with a discussion on the management of hypertension and emphasized the lifestyle modifications that can help in curbing this health condition. The second presentation discussed the topic of disaster hypertension, its mechanism, clinical picture and management options. Overall, it was an informative session and all attendees gained valuable insights and knowledge on these important topics.




