# **Introduction from the ISH Secretary**

We have GREAT news this month as we announce that our president Bryan Williams has been appointed Chief Scientific and Medical Officer of the British Heart Foundation. A great achievement for Bryan, but also great for the BHF to have him! But we have sad news as well, as we have been informed of the passing of Richard Gordon, a pioneer of endocrinology and hypertension research in Australia.

We also report this month on an important statement for treating hypertension globally, which was recently published by the WHO and US CDC initiative HEARTS in collaboration with 11 partner organizations, including ISH. Eoin is an international figure in hypertension research and blood pressure measurement and is author of several books, not only in medicine but also in literature which indeed his new book nicely combined.


#### Discussing tough problems in hypertension on ESC TV


