

Expert Tips on Writing an Award-Winning Abstract (collated from the video series)

"An abstract is the gateway to showcase your research".

- 1. An abstract should be concise, informative, and impactful.
- 2. Follow the abstract outline and guidelines set by the conference convenor. Stay within the word count.
- 3. In the methods section include study design, sample size, and relevant statistical tests used. Do not include results in the methods section.
- 4. In the results section, report the key findings that support the conclusions of the study. Include data and not only statistical test results.
- 5. Be transparent about the study limitations no study is perfect. Do not over-conclude or over-speculate on findings.
- 6. Get feedback from co-authors and colleagues. Send out abstracts to co-authors early and consider the approval process.
- 7. Proof-read for errors.
